#### **BONSAI ENTRY:**

- 1. This Entry Form is designed to be completed electronically. To create an entry you need to download the form, rename it to a unique name, and then save it under that name. Please email your entry to Nandita D'Souza, or it can be printed and mailed to Nandita D'Souza, 32211 Waterford Crest Lane, Weston Lakes, TX. 77441. If you experience problems with the form, please email ndas27@gmail.com. Please complete the entire form.
- 2. There is an entry fee of \$25 per display, payable when you check-in to the exhibit. You will not be able to set up your display until the entry fee is paid.
- 3. The form is designed for one display per entry regardless of whether it is a single bonsai, a multiple tree shohin display, viewing stone or kusamono.. Size limit of shohin is 8", measured from the rim of pot.
- 4. Your display should fit on a standard table with a depth of 30". We will provide a 4' or 6' section of the tables for your display. Please contact us if you plan to display an imperial size or very heavy tree that requires a specially constructed table.
- 5. Provide a photograph of your proposed entry from the front in either .pdf or .jpeg format. The photograph should be good quality but does not need to be professional.

- 6. All entries should be submitted by April 1, 2024
- 7. All displays must be at the exhibition staging area between 12 noon and 6:00 PM, Thursday, April 25, 2024.
- 8. Displays may be removed from the exhibition hall beginning at 12 noon, April 28, 2024, and must be removed by 3:00 PM that day.

#### **VIEWING STONES AND KUSAMONO ENTRIES:**
